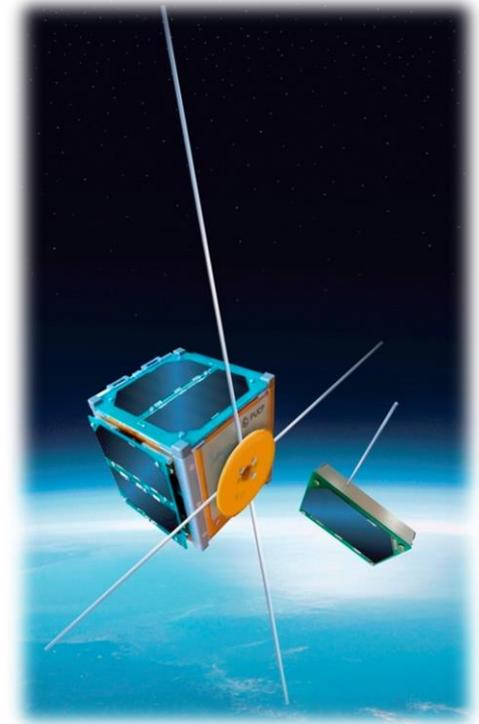
- 24 997 enrolled students (per semester).

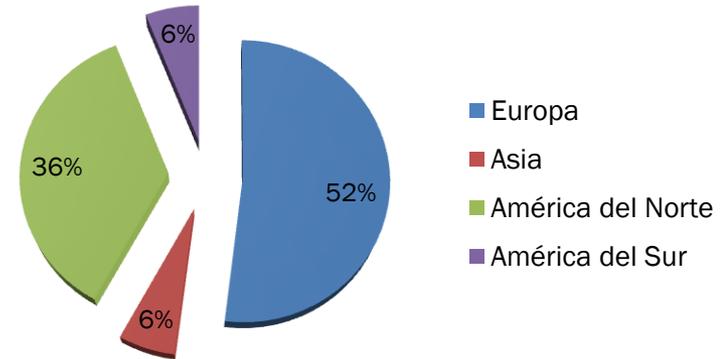
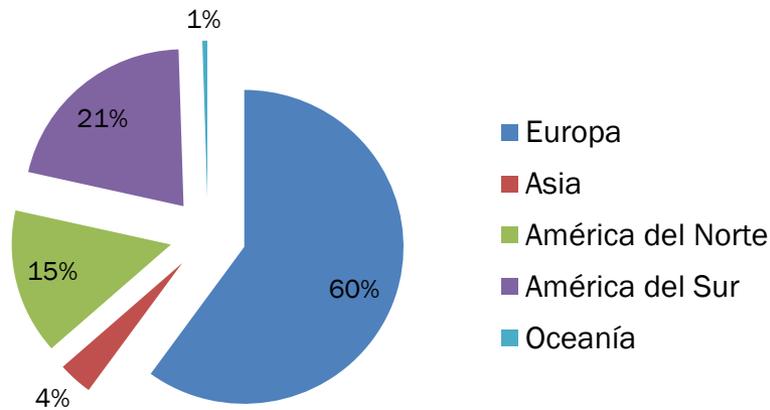
- 17 research institutes and centers.
